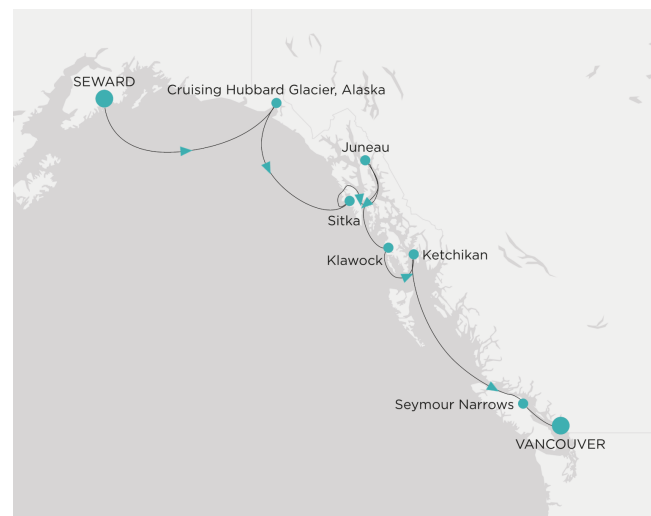


# SEWARD, ALASKA TO VANCOUVER

Embark on an unforgettable Alaskan adventure that sets sail from the mountain-ringed town of Seward. Cruising past the spectacular Hubbard Glacier, we reach Sitka, where evidence of its former Russian rule can be seen in the onion-shaped dome of Saint Michael's Cathedral. Alaska's cultured capital Juneau is next, where you can dive into the state's capital at the museum and take the cable car to the top of Mount Roberts for a scenic overview. Next is Klawock, a significant center of Tlingit culture, from where you can also explore the aptly named Misty Fjords National Park. In Ketchikan, marvel at the houses balancing on stilts over the water, plus an impressive collection of 19th-century totem poles. Crossing into Canadian waters next and cruising through the awe-inspiring Seymour Narrows brings us to our final destination, the lively city of Vancouver.
