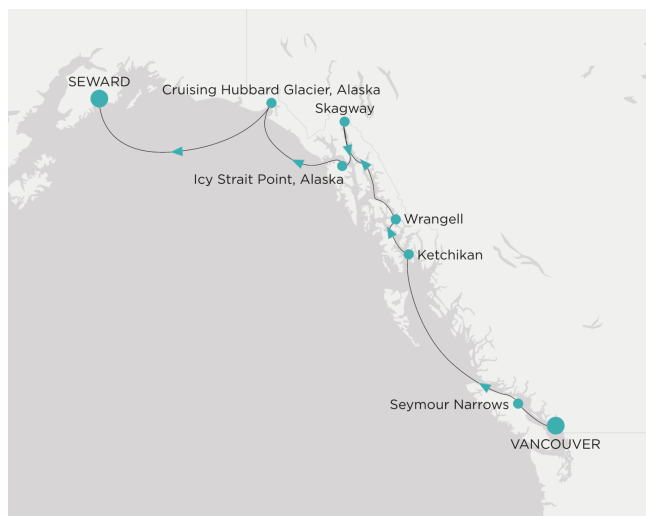


VANCOUVER TO SEWARD, ALASKA

Experience historic Alaskan towns and natural wonders aplenty on this northbound cruise from Vancouver, Canada, to Seward. We begin with a passage through the awe-inspiring Seymour Narrows which takes us to Ketchikan, where houses are built on stilts over the water and there's an impressive collection of 19th-century totem poles to admire. Wrangell is next, home of the Tlingit people and 8,000-year-old rock paintings. There's beauty at every turn in Skagway, from the natural splendor of mountains and glaciers to beautifully preserved Gold Rush-era buildings. At Icy Strait Point, pay a visit to a restored salmon cannery and keep an eye out for humpback whales, before witnessing the spectacle of the mighty Hubbard Glacier up close as we glide slowly past. Our final destination is the charming coastal town of Seward.
